

Passenger self-declaration

The passenger declares, under his own responsibility, to be aware that to travel on ITALO trains, starting from 1 September 2021:

▪ **It is mandatory:**

- i. To be in possession of a Green Pass (apart from subjects excluded by age from the vaccination campaign and subjects exempted based on a suitable medical certification issued according to the criteria defined by the circular of the Ministry of Health pursuant to Decree-Law 111 of 6 August 2021).
- ii. Not to have had close contact with a person affected by Covid 19 in the last 2 days before the onset of symptoms and up to 14 days after their onset (term reduced to 7 days if it is a subject who has completed the vaccination cycle).

▪ **It is necessary:**

- i. To notify the competent health authority, as well as ITALO, of the onset of COVID 19 symptoms within eight days after the end of the trip, specifying the railway services used.
- ii. To expressly accept the general conditions for the transport of passengers and comply with all "anti-Covid 19" security measures. Passenger information will be processed in compliance with the legislation on the protection of personal data (complete information available on the Italo Treno website).

By accepting the conditions required for the purchase of an Italo ticket, you confirm that you have read them all and expressly declare the veracity of the information provided for yourself and for any other passengers for whom you intend to purchase a travel ticket ITALO.

Italo security provisions regarding COVID-19

- In compliance with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 111 of 6 August 2021, for travel on ITALO trains starting from 1 September 2021, the possession of a Green Pass is mandatory for all passengers. Italo staff will carry out controls and verification of Green Pass possession on board the train.
- Passengers must wear surgical masks for the protection of nose and mouth for the entire duration of the trip and provide for their change in case of trips longer than 4 hours.
- To identify all passengers and manage any cases of presence on board of suspected or full-blown positive cases of the Covid-19 virus, the name and surname of all travelers (corresponding to those shown on a valid identity document) must be provided when purchasing tickets.
- Travel should be avoided in case of symptoms of acute respiratory infections (fever, cough, cold).
- The use of the access doors indicated for getting on and off the train is mandatory.
- Passengers should only use the seats indicated on their ticket (seat changes are not allowed while the train is running);
- Displacements on board the train should be limited.
